

# Anduhyaun Inc. Nekenaan Second Stage Housing Application Form

Nekenaan Second Stage Housing offers transitional housing to **Indigenous women, with or** without children who have suffered from the impacts of violence and/or abuse, and who are working to make positive changes in their lives. The goal of Nekenaan Second Stage Housing is to provide women and their family access to the supports and skills they will need to find and maintain permanent housing.

The length of stay at Nekenaan Second Stage Housing is not intended for more than one year.

Nekenaan Second Stage Housing offers 24 furnished units that can house up to a family of five (5), including one accessible unit.

#### **Application Instructions:**

- 1) Complete **ALL** areas on the application form.
- 2) Read and initial the Housing Policies form. If you have any questions, please contact Nekenaan.
- 3) Include verification of your Indigenous ancestry. This can be a photocopy of your status card or letter from your Band Office. This will be required prior to acceptance of move in.

Upon receipt of your application, Nekenaan Second Stage Housing will contact you to arrange an interview.

The Housing Interview/Assessment will take approximately one (1) hour and will include questions that may be sensitive in nature for young children. For applicants with children, please try to arrange for childcare during the scheduled interview/assessment time.

# Anduhyaun Inc. Nekenaan Second Stage Housing Policies

- For the safety and security of all tenants and Anduhyaun staff, <u>NO MEN OR (EX)</u> <u>PARTNERS SHALL BE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING OR UNIT</u>. This policy includes all male relatives and male friends that are 18 years of age and older.
- 2. All tenants of Nekenaan have survived some form of abuse. As this Second Stage Housing Program has been developed specifically as a home for survivors of abuse, tenants must ensure there is no physical, verbal, emotional or sexual abuse against children, tenants, Nekenaan staff and building contractors. Anduhyaun affirms the individual's inherent right to self-determination and equality and to live in a society free of discrimination and harassment based on age, gender, race, colour, language, spiritual beliefs, religion and sexual orientation.
- 3. No alcohol, firearms, weapons and illegal drugs allowed on Anduhyaun premises.
- 4. Tenants must not let unknown people into the building. In consideration of ensuring safety and security for all tenants, it is the responsibility of tenants to admit their own guests, at the front door of the building.
- 5. Visiting female guests and male (under the age of 18) guests are allowed at Nekenaan units during the hours of 7:00 am to 11:00 pm. Visits from guests after these hours will require prior permission from Nekenaan staff as per Nekenaan Guest Policy.
- 6. There is no parking at the Anduhyaun building for tenants or their guests.
- 7. All school aged children must be enrolled and in regular attendance at school.
- 8. Each tenant will assume personal responsibility for making her own childcare arrangements. Nekenaan staff will not assume responsibility for childcare.
- 9. No pets are allowed in the building, unless they are a certified service animal.
- 10. This is a non-smoking building. There is no smoking in the unit, in the common rooms, on the common room balconies, or in the stairwells.
- 11. All tenants will be entitled to privacy, peace and good order within her own unit.
